

AVECCTN Skills List Picture Requirements List by Skill

New! Look at the ICONS to help determine what is required in your pictures!

ICON	Definition
	Picture requires all tubing, and/or catheters needed to demonstrate the skill.
	Picture requires IV solution bags, blood bags, pressure bags, etc. to be visible.
	Picture requires the patient (or body part) to be visible.
	Picture requires medical equipment necessary for the skill.
	Certificate ONLY required.
	The Applicant must appear in the picture performing the skill.

Skill	Picture Required
<u>Skill 6:</u> Ability to properly place and maintain peripherally inserted CENTRAL catheters (e.g. PICC line, long line)	Skill 6 requires a picture. Please upload a picture of a FULLY INSERTED AND SECURED catheter without the covering bandage or drape so that the insertion site may be assessed. Ensure that the skill card is clearly visible in the photo without obscuring any part of the catheter. Do not include identifiable features of the patient. You may blur out identifiable features if unable to crop the photo adequately. 
<u>Skill 7:</u> Ability to properly place and maintain multi-lumen jugular catheters.	Skill 7 requires a picture. Please upload a picture of a FULLY INSERTED AND SECURED catheter without the covering bandage or drape so that the insertion site may be assessed. Ensure that the skill card is clearly visible in the photo without obscuring any part of the catheter. Do not include identifiable features of the patient. You may blur out identifiable features if unable to crop the photo adequately. 
<u>Skill 8:</u> Ability to properly administer and monitor blood product component therapy	Skill 8 requires a picture. Please upload a picture of a properly setup blood product transfusion in progress. Ensure that ALL components of the transfusion are in the picture, from the product to the patient. Note: this has changed from the previous picture requirements for transfusions! Ensure that the skill card is clearly visible in the photo without obscuring any part of the transfusion. Do not include identifiable features of the patient. You may blur out identifiable features if unable to crop the photo adequately. 
<u>Skill 11:</u> Participate in all aspects of basic life support (BLS) including cardiopulmonary arrest (CPA) assessment, chest compressions, and manual ventilation. *Online RECOVER certificate required	Skill 11 requires a current RECOVER BLS Online Certificate. Please upload certificate below and ensure that the expiry date of your certificate is <u>past the application due date of October 31.</u> 

<u>Skill 12:</u> Participate in all aspects of advanced life support (ALS) including vascular access, emergency drug administration, ECG rhythm assessment, and ETCO2 assessment. *Online RECOVER Certificate required	Skill 12 requires a current RECOVER ALS Online Certificate. Please upload certificate below and ensure that the expiry date of your certificate is <u>past the application due date of October 31.</u> 
<u>Skill 15:</u> Administer and manage intralipid emulsion (ILE) therapy.	Skill 15 requires a picture. Please upload a picture of a properly setup ILE therapy in progress. Ensure that ALL components of the procedure are in the picture, from the <u>product to the patient.</u> Ensure that the skill card is clearly visible in the photo without obscuring any part of the infusion. Do not include identifiable features of the patient. You may blur out identifiable features if unable to crop the photo adequately. 
<u>Skill 27:</u> Ability to place intraosseous catheters.	Skill 27 requires a picture. Please upload a picture of a FULLY INSERTED AND SECURED catheter <i>without</i> the covering bandage or drape so that the insertion site <u>may be assessed.</u> Ensure that the skill card is clearly visible in the photo without obscuring any part of the catheter. Do not include identifiable features of the patient. You may blur out identifiable features if unable to crop the photo adequately. 
<u>Skill 29:</u> Ability to perform arterial catheterization.	Skill #29 requires a picture. Please upload a picture of a FULLY INSERTED AND SECURED catheter <i>without</i> the covering bandage or drape so that the insertion site <u>may be assessed.</u> Ensure that the skill card is clearly visible in the photo without obscuring any part of the catheter. Do not include identifiable features of the patient. You may blur out identifiable features if unable to crop the photo adequately. 
<u>Skill 30:</u> Ability to safely perform external defibrillation.	Skill 30 requires an <u>EQUIPMENT ONLY</u> picture. Please upload a picture a functioning defibrillator available at YOUR clinic where you work. <u>Do NOT submit a picture of defibrillation in progress.</u> Ensure that the skill card is clearly visible in the photo. 

<u>Skill 31:</u> <i>Demonstrated ability to setup, maintain and monitor direct arterial pressure.</i>	Skill 31 requires a picture. <u>Please upload a picture of a properly setup direct blood pressure in progress. Ensure that ALL components of the procedure are in the picture, from the product to the patient. Include the waveform in the picture.</u> Ensure that the skill card is clearly visible in the photo without obscuring any part of the infusion. Do not include identifiable features of the patient. You may blur out identifiable features if unable to crop the photo adequately. 
<u>Skill 32:</u> <i>Ability to monitor and care for patients with thoracostomy tubes.</i>	Skill 32 requires a picture. <u>Please upload a picture of a patient with a thoracostomy tube in place. Ensure that it is clear that the tube is a thoracostomy tube by including a large portion of the chest.</u> Ensure that the skill card is clearly visible in the photo without obscuring any part of the tube and anatomy. Do not include identifiable features of the patient. You may blur out identifiable features if unable to crop the photo adequately. 
<u>Skill 33:</u> <i>Ability to care for, maintain and monitor patients with tracheostomy tubes.</i>	Skill 33 requires a picture. Please upload a picture of a patient with a tracheostomy tube in place. Ensure that it is clear that the tube is a tracheostomy tube by including a large portion of the neck area. Ensure that the skill card is clearly visible in the photo without obscuring any part of the tube and anatomy. Do not include identifiable features of the patient. You may blur out identifiable features if unable to crop the photo adequately. 
<u>Skill 34:</u> <i>Ability to setup, maintain and monitor continuous closed chest drainage systems (e.g. Thoraseal®, Sentinel Seal®, Pleurovac® etc.)</i>	Skill 34 requires a picture. Please upload a picture of a patient on a continuous closed chest drainage system. Ensure that ALL parts are visible, including the thoracostomy tube, tubing and closed chest drainage system. Ensure that the skill card is clearly visible in the photo without obscuring any part of the tube and anatomy. Do not include identifiable features of the patient. You may blur out identifiable features if unable to crop the photo adequately. 

<u>Skill 35:</u> Ability to setup and manage a patient on a critical care mechanical ventilator (e.g. not an anesthetic ventilator, <u>must have ability to change FiO2 percentage</u>)	Skill 35 requires a picture. Please upload a picture of a patient on a critical care ventilator. Ensure that ALL parts are visible, including the patient, tubing and ventilator and that it is clear that the ventilator is breathing for the patient. Ensure that the skill card is clearly visible in the photo without obscuring any part of the tube and anatomy. Do not include identifiable features of the patient. You may blur out identifiable features if unable to crop the photo adequately. 
<u>Skill 36:</u> Ability to setup and manage a patient on high flow nasal oxygen therapy.	Skill 36 requires a picture. Please upload a picture of a patient receiving high flow nasal oxygen therapy. Ensure that ALL parts are visible, including the patient, tubing and high flow unit and that it is clear that the high flow is in use and functioning. Ensure that the skill card is clearly visible in the photo without obscuring any part of the tube and anatomy. Do not include identifiable features of the patient. You may blur out identifiable features if unable to crop the photo adequately. 
<u>Skill 39:</u> Ability to manage patients undergoing advanced renal replacement therapy (e.g. peritoneal dialysis, hemodialysis, CRRT, total plasma exchange, etc.).	Skill 39 requires a picture. Please upload a picture of a patient receiving renal replacement therapy or TPE. Ensure that ALL parts are visible, including the patient, tubing and any equipment required and that it is clear that the patient is receiving this therapy. Ensure that the skill card is clearly visible in the photo without obscuring any part of the tube and anatomy. Do not include identifiable features of the patient. You may blur out identifiable features if unable to crop the photo adequately. 
<u>Skill 40:</u> Ability to administer and manage patients on Total Parenteral Nutrition (TPN) and / or Partial Parenteral Nutrition (PPN)	Skill 40 requires a picture. Please upload a picture of a patient receiving PPN or TPN. Ensure that ALL parts are visible, including the patient, nutrient bags, tubing and any equipment required and that it is clear that the patient is receiving this therapy. Ensure that the skill card is clearly visible in the photo without obscuring any part of the tube and anatomy. Do not include identifiable features of the patient. You may blur out identifiable features if unable to crop the photo adequately. 

<u>Skill 41:</u> Ability to perform and interpret thoracic point of care ultrasound (POCUS).	Skill 41 requires a picture. Please upload a picture of the applicant performing thoracic POCUS. Ensure that ALL parts are visible, including the applicant, patient, and ultrasound with screen showing. Ensure that the skill card is clearly visible in the photo without obscuring any part of the tube and anatomy. Do not include identifiable features of the patient. You may blur out identifiable features if unable to crop the photo adequately. 
<u>Skill 42:</u> Ability to perform and interpret abdominal point of care ultrasound (POCUS)	Skill 42 requires a picture. Please upload a picture of the applicant performing abdominal POCUS. Ensure that ALL parts are visible, including the applicant, patient, and ultrasound with screen showing. Ensure that the skill card is clearly visible in the photo without obscuring any part of the tube and anatomy. Do not include identifiable features of the patient. You may blur out identifiable features if unable to crop the photo adequately.
